With a team of around 1,300 employees, they strive to manage most of its logistics operations in-house from their headquarters in North-Holland. They have their own e-commerce platform, and while the majority of their revenue comes from physical stores, they are actively working to grow and enhance their online channels.

As a Front-end Developer, you will play a crucial role in driving the profitable growth of their online platforms.
