You will work in a small team developing serious software for the staffing industry. Our client now wants to focus more on implementing standards and improving links so that everything runs well for the staffing agencies. There are also new developments on the finance piece, such as upfront costing with dynamic pricing and machine learning elements. This involves a lot of data, such as travel distance, work history and qualifications.

You will work on expanding the foundation of the software package and continuing to build out the integration pipeline.
